Dear Miss Yvonne Wheeler and Members of the Executive Board,

We are writing to urgently request that the Los Angeles County Federation of Labor, the Central Labor Council representing the largest county in the United States, heed the call of workers at home and abroad.

Israel's crimes are only possible because of more than \$3.8 billion a year (or \$10+ million *per day*) in bipartisan US military aid that gives Israel the guns, bullets, tanks, ships, jet fighters, missiles, helicopters, white phosphorus and other weapons to kill and maim the Palestinian people. This is the same system of racist state violence that, through shared surveillance technology and police exchange programs, brutalizes BIPOC and working class people in the United States and around the world.

We are calling upon the Los Angeles County Labor Federation to issue a statement demanding an immediate end to the genocide, and further reaffirm the call on labor bodies to respect <u>previous Palestinian trade union appeals for</u> solidarity by adopting this statement, and/or the model resolution to divest from Israel Bonds, and respect the Palestinian picket line for Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS), which calls not only for an end to the 1967 Israeli occupation, but an end to Israeli occupation and colonization of all Arab lands and dismantling the Wall, full equality for Arab-Palestinians inside 1948 Palestine, and implementation of the right of Palestinian refugees to return.

We thank you for your attention on this matter and look forward to your response.
