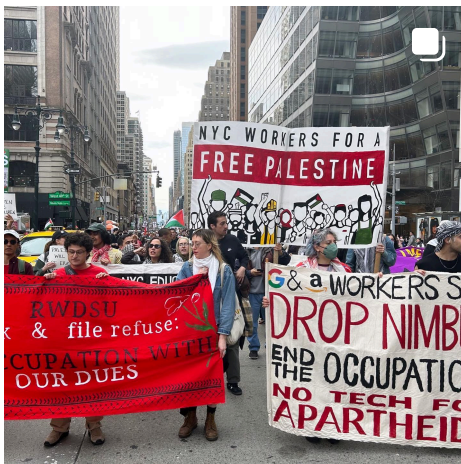

**DAY MATTER TO WORKERS IN THE U.S?**

March 30, or Land Day, commemorates the time in 1975-76 when Palestinians initiated demonstrations and a general strike across Palestine to protest the growing Zionist land theft and displacement that culminated in the murder of six Palestinians, 50 wounded, and 300 arrested in 1976. Since then, March 30th has become a mobilizing day to commemorate the ongoing dispossession of Palestinian land and exploitation of their labor.

**LAND IS LIFE ITSELF**

Return to the land comprises sovereignty over labor and the ability to guide the development of productive forces. So, the labor movement is a powerful and indispensable part of the liberation struggle in Palestine, as it has been in liberation movements throughout world history. Some of the first forms of resistance employed by Palestinians were general strikes, refusing to work on settled territory.

solidarity played a key part in supporting liberation movements, such as fighting apartheid in Africa. Unions are a powerful pressure uncooperative governments, to educate the masses and to stop direct support of companies that are helping oppressive states.

**WE ARE FIGHTING THE SAME SYSTEMS AND WE MUST UNITE OUR STRUGGLES.**

We know that the same repressive tools developed by Israel are bought and used by oppressive regimes to target organizers of all kind, including labor.

Finally, as Palestinian Trade Unions wrote: "As Israel escalates its military campaign, Palestinian trade unions call on our counterparts internationally and all people of conscience to end all forms of complicity with Israel's crimes - most urgently halting the arms trade with Israel, as well as all funding and military research. The time for action is now - Palestinian lives hang in the balance!"

We have seen workers around the world take direct action to stand against the genocidal Israeli state. Actions such as:

- Dockworkers refusing to load weapons on ships
- Tech workers fighting to stop
